



A MESSAGE FROM ZION'S PERSONNEL COMMITTEE . . .



In Recognition and Thanks for Pastor and Ministry Staff

- Worship service is held every Sunday.
- The Gospel is preached and a sermon delivered by our Pastor every Sunday.
- Hymns are sung each Sunday, with the Pianist and Organist providing leadership.
- Microphones are turned up, and service power points are displayed on Sunday morning. Service is live-streamed and uploaded for viewing from home or other remote locations by our Audio Video Technician.
- All of the above is also done during mid-week services that continue to be provided.
- Confirmation instruction is provided by Pastor Barry every week.
- Youth and Adult education is provided by our Youth and Family Coordinator each week.
- Special devotions (ex. daily Lenten devotions) are provided by our Youth and Family Coordinator each week.
- Bulletins and announcements are prepared, printed and e-mailed each Sunday by our Office Manager.
- The Horizon is prepared, proofed, printed and disseminated by USPS and e-mail each month, coordinated by the Office Manager.
- Phone calls and emails to the church are addressed by our Office Manager.
- Pastoral Care to those who are homebound, in nursing homes, ill or dying are provided under our Pastoral Visitation contract with Pastor Marney.

If these were 'normal' times, you would be thinking....and your point?

What makes this remarkable is that these responsibilities, as well as a plethora of less-visible tasks carried out by Pastor Barry, ministry staff (Office Manager, Youth and Family Coordinator, Pastoral Visitation, Pianist, Organist, Sound and Video Technician), and volunteers have continued to be performed in the midst of the Covid 19 pandemic.

All of us have, to varying degrees, been under a great deal of stress over the last year. Our Pastor and staff are no exception. This has probably been one of the hardest 12 months that Pastor Barry has had to endure in his ministry career. He has had to re-visualize and re-direct how he carries out his pastoral responsibilities under his Letter of Call to Zion. When it became evident that we were facing a pandemic, the burden of how to ensure we stay connected as a congregation to worship & his responsibility to minister without the traditional in-person fellowship fell primarily to Pastor. Seminary did not prepare Pastor Barry for a pandemic, and, added to that challenge, he had to interpret and reconcile health mandates coming from all levels of government. Pastor provided leadership early on in forming a task force at Zion to address logistical and technological crisis as we navigated how to open our doors safely for congregants to worship on site and to participate in those services remotely. He was both hands-on in that effort as well as providing necessary support to staff and volunteers, both as they worked to meet that goal early on in the Pandemic, and as the group continues today to address changes in health and safety mandates. Incredibly, we have been able to conduct all worship services, even during the shutdown that commenced close to Holy week. Proactive and swift decision-making at that time by Pastor Barry, with input and participation from staff and volunteers, enabled us to pre-record services for delayed broadcast.

The ministry staff for their part, has had to re-invent and re-build how to carry out their respective responsibilities. They have shown courage, creativity, flexibility and perseverance in the face of some having to learn new technologies and encountering unforeseen obstacles and difficulties along the way.

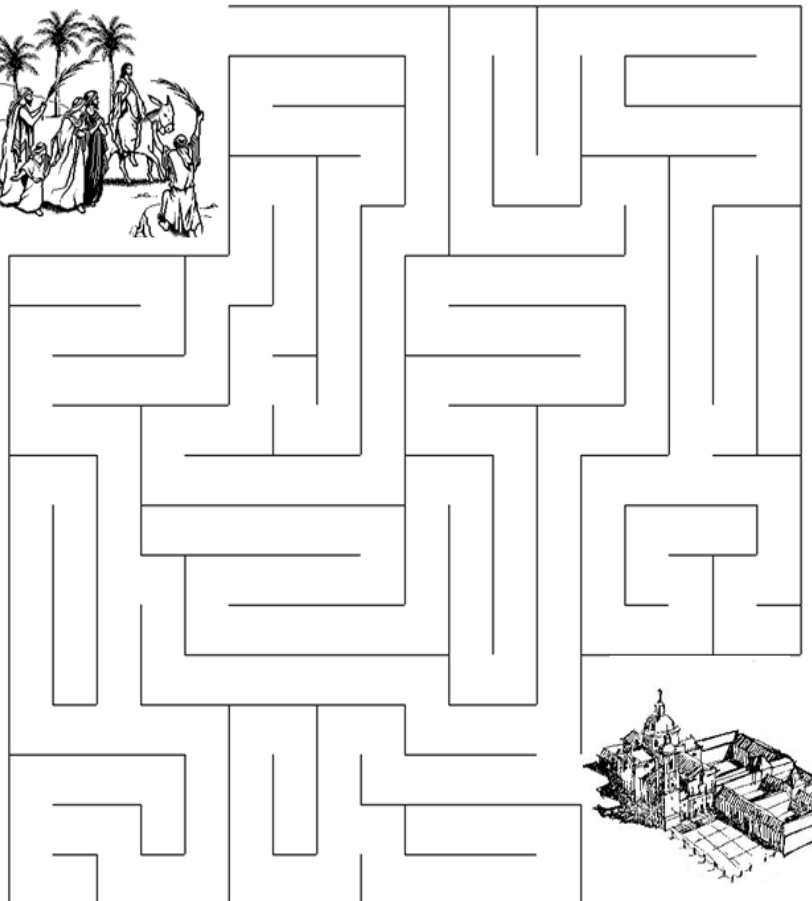

New Business & Action Items:

- **Motion** from Personnel Cm **to approve** Modification #1 to Worship and Choir Pianist Contract. This is to add fee structure items missed in the 2021 contract. It does not affect the 2021 budget. **MSP**
- The **new council members** made their committee choices. Staci will join Youth & Family Ministries and Theresa will join the Stewardship Cm. Marion is already on the Property Cm and Jill replaces Paul on the Personnel Cm.
- **Motion to appoint** Johanna as Financial Secretary for 2021. **MSP**
- **Youth & Family Cm** “**recommends** all committees submit meeting minutes to the Office Manager so that the minutes can be saved digitally for possible future use.” The committees currently send minutes to the Council Secretary for incorporation into the Council minutes, and that position is responsible for archival copies of the minutes per the Bylaws, so digital copies already exist. After Council has reviewed the minutes, they are sent to the Office Manager for posting and inclusion in the Horizon.
- The **Annual Congregational Meeting** was discussed. Zoom attendees were polled and their votes on the budget tabulated, which resulted in the budget passing. The results will be added to the minutes of the annual meeting.
- **Motion that Zion allocate \$10,000** from net proceeds from 2020 to benevolences and include any special offerings to increase benevolences for 2021, on top of the 5% already allocated in the budget. **MSP** with 1 objection. Council will send a letter to the congregation regarding the budget & benevolences.
- **Council members will be installed** at the February 21st worship service.

- **Pastor updated us on Covid restrictions.** As of January 11th, small groups may again meet at the church, as long as they don't exceed 25% of full capacity. Pastor has notified most of the groups who hold meetings at church.
- **Sunshine Mtn update:** Preparations are underway for a virtual open house the week of February 22nd. In person classes will begin the week of March 1st with masks required. No parents will be allowed in the building and class size is limited to 12 students.
- **Sunday School in-person classes** will resume this fall.
- **All committees** are again reminded to send notices of meetings to the Office Manager for inclusion in the calendar and weekly announcements.

They worked collaboratively as a team, held each other up as fellow members of the Body of Christ, and never expressed defeat.

The lights are off in the church office much of the time, as our Pastor and Ministry Staff work from home to carry out their responsibilities. As with a considerable portion of the workforce in a traditional office setting, and thanks in large part to technology, much of the labor has shifted from being performed in an office, behind a desk, behind a computer at church, with frequent face to face conversations to these tasks being performed remotely, relying almost entirely on email, phone, text message, and Zoom to effectively communicate. In part, for this reason, there are some tasks that actually require a greater investment of time and work under telework. It is important to recognize that these activities may look different now than they did a year ago, and may for some time, but the content continues to be in line with Pastor's Letter of Call, staff contracts, and in keeping with fulfilling the ministry to the congregation and our greater community.

How can we lift up and care for our Pastor and Ministry Staff, especially during this difficult time?

We can read the weekly bulletin announcements and the Pastor and staff reports in the monthly Horizon newsletter to stay apprised of what they are doing, especially that which might not be as visibly evident on a Sunday morning. We can participate in the educational opportunities offered at Zion that are provided by our Pastor and staff to strengthen our faith; youth Sunday School, adult bible study, the daily Lenten devotions. This may mean that we, too, may need to go outside our comfort zone and learn unfamiliar media platforms like Zoom, Facebook, YouTube or other websites. We can make a special effort to reply when asked for a response or feedback. We can look for opportunities to thank Pastor and staff for the gifts and talents they contribute to the ministry of Zion. We can apply grace and forgiveness when mistakes are made. Pastor and staff are flawed sinners as we all are. Accountability is important, but in context with the event. We can ask if what is perceived as someone falling short in their performance is a symptom of a larger issue outside of their control. We can have constructive conversations with respective committees and Council on issues that are of concern early on, taking time to listen and to understand any challenges that our Pastor, staff and leadership faces on the subject, and ask ourselves how we might be part of the solution. We can ask to sit on standing committee meetings or even join a standing committee, particularly where you can use your gifts and talents to further the ministry at Zion. We can regard the budget that is dedicated to Pastor and staff pay as an investment in our spiritual well-being; feeding and fortifying us to go forth to love and serve our neighbor, all to His glory rather than an expense to be minimized.

Above all, we can keep our Pastor and staff, and their families, in our prayers. We do not know what worship and other church activities will look like as Covid-19 restrictions ebb or flow. We cannot know what changes in direction Zion may need to take and the impact any changes may have on our Pastor and ministry staff as they strive to carry out their responsibilities. We can ask that Christ continue to protect and guide them in service to Zion.
